But Strattis in the Macedonians or Pausanias, says she was a Corinthian, in these lines:  "a. Whence come these girls, and who are they? b. Just now they have come from Megara, but they are Corinthian; first there is Lais here, belonging to Megacles."  (ATHENAEUS OF NAUCRATIS, The Deipnosophists, XIII, 589a. Translated by Ch.
